## **Explanatory Circular regarding the December 1987 Edition of the Repatriation Schedule of Pharmaceutical Benefits.**

This reprint of the Schedule will take effect on **1 December 1987** and all previous editions of the Schedule are cancelled.

### **RPBS Prescribing of Benzodiazepines**

At its last meeting the Repatriation Pharmaceutical Reference Committee again reviewed the prescribing of **Benzodiazepines** under the Repatriation Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (RPBS). Because of the continuing medical evidence reported in the literature on problems of dependence and abuse associated with the long term use of these substances, the Committee recommended that the listing of **Benzodiazepines** under the RPBS be aligned with the policy of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) aimed at limiting treatment to short term usage. Accordingly, in this Edition of the Schedule the listings for **Benzodiazepines** which provide for the prescribing of a larger quantity, have been removed.

### **Restricted Prescribing of Incontinence Aids**

Incontinence aids should not be prescribed for patients in nursing homes. The approved patient fee paid to nursing homes includes a component for the supply of incontinence aids by the nursing home. For prescriber information a restriction note for absorbent napkins and absorbent napkins pants has been added to the Schedule.
